Hill's Fort Rendezvous and Blanket Shoot Located on grounds of the American Farm Heritage Museum Rt. 127 just south of I-70, Greenville, IL September 14-16, 2018

Hill's Fort Rendezvous and Blanket Shoot is a recreation of the traditional military/militia and frontier life of the 18th century. Join with the military/militia, artisans, authors, and entertainers as they celebrate this time in history at the 1800's replicated Hill's Fort near Greenville, Illinois.

Registration and Set-up: Registration and set-up will be from 9 a.m to 8 p.m. Thursday, September 13th and site should remain intact until 3:30 on Sunday, September 16 2018 (breaking down prior to this time is discouraged). Within a reasonable amount of time you should be set up, in period clothing, and move your vehicle to 'Participant Parking'. Vehicles are not be be kept in the camping area overnight even before Friday. This means that whatever day you set up, your vehicle does not return to Primitive Camping until after Evening Colors at 3:30 pm on Sunday, September 16, 2018. Once your camp is set up and your vehicle moved, participants must be in period dress. No blue jeans, bib overalls and/or tennis shoes.

Prohibited:

Sale of the following items are prohibited: food or drink without prior registration of a food booth, artsy/crafty painted items, fluorescent feathers, face painting, bird houses, bamboo flutes, Central and South American items, Southwestern items, enamelware, non-period jewelry, plastic items and protective coverings, dream catchers, pop guns, artifacts, fossils, minerals, items with Southwestern designs, black powder, percussion firearms, percussion supplies, "Pow-Wow" items, ALL painted animals skulls/bones/shells, soapstone containers, and harmonicas. No whips, no parasols, no bows and arrows.

Solid wooden rifles and pistols will be allowed.

NOTE: All participants doing demonstrations will be required to complete a Liability Waiver on site.

<u>Essentials</u>: Please do not bring firewood to the Rendezvous. According to the USDA and IDNR reports, the Emerald Ash Borer is potentially disastrous to all ash trees in the state and is being brought to new areas in firewood. We ask that you do not remove firewood from the site as well. Thank you for your cooperation.

Water and firewood will be provided. Flush toilets on site. By City Ordinance, pets must be on a leash at all times. Noise curfew of 11:00 pm will be enforced.

Plastic tarps and aluminum cots should be concealed. Aluminum lawn chairs are prohibited. For safety reasons, no loaded firearms will be permitted in camp. No fireworks.

Modern conveniences, i.e., drink cans and bottles, plastic food packaging, coolers, etc., should be concealed. Bottles and cans should be disposed of each day away from the Fort. Containers and bags will be available. Radios, tape players, non-period music, gas and kerosene lanterns and stoves are prohibited. Before you leave, please help by returning all unused firewood to the woodpile.

The digging of fire pits is permitted. The organizers ask that the pits be filled in at the close of camp on Sunday.

Hotels are available nearby.

Directions: Illinois Route 127 at Interstate 70 in Greenville, Illinois. Access road is 200 yards south of I-70 at Exit 45 on Rt 127 on east side across from motel and before the RV shop. Signs say Farm Heritage Museum and also Hill's Fort.
